#### Beat that Louse

We have recently had several cases of head lice reported. Please can you be extra vigilant and check your children's hair. Although lice can be seen in dry hair, the best way to check is by the combing of wet hair with a fine toothed "detector" comb and treating if necessary, every three or four days for two weeks or until you cannot see any eggs. Treatment can either be by using over the counter treatments from the chemist, or the wet comb method and using lots of hair conditioner.

#### Lunch Boxes

A request from the Hall Committee to remind parents to take home their children's lunch boxes at the end of each day please. Monday through to Thursday the boxes will be left outside the hall doors. However on a Friday any lunch boxes left at school will be locked inside the hall from 4.30pm. You will not be able to collect it until Monday morning!
