#### Attendance

We believe that every day matters in a child's education and this is backed up by research to show how crucial regular attendance is in ensuring children reach their full potential.

We urge, as parents that you:

- Ensure your child only misses school for reasons which are unavoidable, such as illness
- Always notify the school on the first morning of absence
- Try to avoid booking a family holiday during term time
- Talk to us if your child is reluctant to come to school.

In line with other primary schools, we would like to aim for 97% or above for every child's attendance this year.
