Rivers project at Winchester College

Oak Class completed a fascinating field study Rivers Project on the River Itchen this week, led by Geography Teacher Clare Talks and staff from the Wessex Chalk Stream and Rivers Trust. Our young geographers learned about the importance of this famous chalk stream, which flows through our city of Winchester. They studied the hydrology and Wildlife of the River Itchen, and the creatures and plants that live in it. The study culminated in the classic investigation of measuring the surface velocity of the river by timing how long an orange takes to travel a distance of 10 metres. We are looking forward to our follow- up session in the biology laboratory next week.
