School Breakfast Club

We are delighted to say that we have decided to run a trial Breakfast Club in the Summer Term. This club will start **on Tuesday 3rd May**.

- The club will operate Monday to Friday from 8.00am to 8.50am and will be available for Year R to Year 6 pupils.
- The cost per session is £4.50 and this includes breakfast which will be a choice of cereals and juices.
- Children can be dropped off at any time between 8.00am and 8.50am but would need to arrive by 8.20am to receive breakfast. The cost will be the same regardless of arrival time.
- The Breakfast club will be operated and staffed by the school.

This will **not** be an adhoc service. We therefore need parents to book and pay for regular weekly slots, half-termly in advance. Unfortunately, we cannot refund fees in the event of absence for any reason.

There are only 10 spaces available for this club and these will be booked on a first-come first-served basis, through return of the form below to the office (either paper or electronic copy). Please note, a space will only be reserved once the half-termly payment has been made.

If you would like to reserve a space for your child / children, please complete and sign the form below, indicating which day/days are required. Once we have your confirmation, you will be able to look online using our online payment facility (SCOPAY) to see the amount due for the first half-term of the summer. There is some flexibility for parents to opt in and out of the club; however, we do ask for a minimum of 24 hours' notice for session cancellations, otherwise you may still be charged.

For any child registered in an after-school club who is unable to attend, please inform us of going-home arrangements. We will always hold children at school who are in clubs that are cancelled at short notice due, for example, to inclement weather.

COVID-19 Vaccinations

All children aged 5-11 will now be eligible for their first jabs as the COVID-19 programme rolls the vaccine out across Hampshire and the Isle of Wight.

The vaccine is a specially developed paediatric version for children. Parents are able to access the vaccine through vaccination centres, local pharmacies and GPs.

There has been an overwhelming response from parents who would like to vaccinate their children and teams across Hampshire and Isle of Wight are working hard to provide additional capacity.

Parents are able to find their nearest vaccination site via the NHS website, by calling 119 or by calling the Hampshire and Isle of Wight COVID-19 helpline on 0300 561 0018 which can help find and book slots or direct you to your nearest walk-in.

New sites and vaccination slots are uploaded all the time so please check regularly.
