Some parent reminders for the start of the new school year

• Communication with the school

There are 3 email addresses you may wish to add to your contacts list:

adminoffice@sparsholt.hants.sch.uk - this will send emails to our administration staff and should be used in the first instance. If you wish to direct the email to a specific member of staff, please use this email address and we will forward accordingly.

absence@sparsholt.hants.sch.uk - use this email address to notify us of your child's absence dpo@sparsholt.hants.sch.uk - use this email for data protection questions, queries and issues

eSchools Text Service

We use this texting service to inform parents of emergency school closures, last minute changes to trips and clubs, and reminders of events that are coming up. We can only use one mobile phone number per eldest/only child and we only have use of 160 characters - so expect very brief and to-the-point messages! You are unable to reply directly to any message you receive. We will automatically add the first mobile number located on your child's contact details to the text service database unless you request a different one.

Pupil Mail

We urge you, along with your child, to check book bags at least once per week. You may find letters from the school office or your child's teacher, reading records and homework, and school staff would appreciate it if you could act upon these as soon as possible. • Nut Free School!

We have pupils and staff who have severe allergic reactions to nuts and nut derivatives. This allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) can occur through ingestion of peanut/nut products and cross contamination. Since this condition can be life threatening, we are asking for your help in minimising the risk by:

- avoiding giving your child / children nuts and nut derivatives in school lunches and snacks examples include peanut butter sandwiches, other spreads containing nuts such as Nutella, snacks/bars containing nuts, sesame, pesto, nut oils, nut flours and nut milks. (This list is not exhaustive.)
- reminding children not to share their lunches.

Due to the severity of the problem, it is important that all parents carry out the suggested measures and reduce the risk of an allergic reaction. We thank you for your co-operation.

• Data Information Sheets

In the next week you will be receiving a hard copy of contact and other information we hold on you and your child/children. We request that you check, update and return (even if there are no amendments) so we can check the details we have are up to date. We would appreciate it if you could give us a minimum of 3 contacts in case of emergencies.

• Medicine In School

After School Kid's Club

We offer an extended school provision (After School Kid's Club) for Year R through to Year 6 pupils, Monday to Thursday from 3.35 to 5.30pm during term time. Children take part in design, craft and other activities and during dry weather are able to use the play facilities outside.

If you are interested in starting / continuing to use After School Kid's Club from September 2021 please email the office with your child's name and days required.

Once we have your confirmation, you will be able to look online using our online payment facility to see the amount due for the Autumn Term. The cost is £9 per child per session, **payable termly in advance**. You can pay directly to the school office if you prefer, with cash or cheque payable to Sparsholt Primary School.

We do accept childcare vouchers (from your employer, if you joined their scheme before 4th October 2018) or you may be entitled to **Tax-Free Childcare** instead - visit www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare for more information.

There is some flexibility for parents to opt in and out of the club; however, we do ask for a minimum of 24 hours' notice for session cancellations.
