It was lovely to see you all yesterday and we are looking forward to the New Year Challenge of working together as you complete your learning at home.

On Friday, your teachers will send your first Virtual Learning PowerPoint which will explain how you are going to learn at home over the next few weeks.



Each day you will be sent a step-by -step PowerPoint, which will help to direct your learning and help to guide you through the school day at home. There will sometimes be video links to explain your learning and there will be tasks for you to complete throughout the day.

Your learning at home will follow your normal routine of the School day. Please get washed, dressed ( into your uniform if you like!) have your breakfast and be ready to start your school day at 9.00 am.



### Daily Timetable

As usual, the day will start with early morning activities, which will get your brain ready for learning and give you time to practise important skills. These will be spelling, handwriting and maths activities. After early morning work your next activity will be a reading task followed by an English task.

Your break/ playtime will be at 10.45 for 20 minutes. After break you will do your maths, which will usually start with a video, followed by worksheets for you to complete. After maths it will be lunchtime.

Your afternoon session will start at 1.30pm with quiet reaing for 20 minutes. The lesson in the afternoon will either be, project/topic work, science, art, PSHE or RE.

Your teacher will want to see your learning and will expect you to upload your work everyday by 3.30pm. Please upload to the VLE, on the File tab and share with your teacher. Always remember to name your files with your name.



During the week there will be videos from your teacher encouraging you to do your best and work your hardest. To keep in contact during the next few weeks there will be opportunities for you to join an MS Teams video call with your teacher and classmates. There will be more details about this soon! Remember you can also catch up and chat with your friends on the VLE.
