

2022 Year 1 Phonics Screening Check Results: Headline figures – Sparsholt Church of England Primary School

The phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. It will identify pupils who need extra help to improve their decoding skills.

The check consists of a mixture of 40 real and pseudo-words that a pupil reads aloud to the teacher.

89.5% of Sparsholt pupils attained the expected standard in the Phonics Screening check.

75.4% of pupils in Hampshire attained the expected standard in the Phonics Screening check.

75.5% of **pupils nationally** attained the expected standard in the Phonics Screening check.
