Invitation to talk in our Worship - weeks beginning July 2nd and July 9th

We would like to invite any parents or friends to come in to share an interest or talk about their job. In previous years we have had talks about horses, Iron Man competitor and Working at Waitrose. If you would be willing to come in and talk to the children please let the office know and we can arrange a date. Worship usually takes place at 9.15 am but we can be flexible to suit you.

Attendance

If you have children at King's school you will be aware that the school sends out attendance letters to parents at the end of each term. These letters have a red/amber/green code and they indicate whether a child's attendance is cause for celebration or concern. Anything at 95% or above is coded green, between 90% and 94.99% is amber and below 90% is red. The reason for notifying parents is because of evidence that children's achievement at school is negatively affected by an attendance rate that is below 95%

In line with other primary schools, we are also going to start sending out a letter along similar lines three times a year from September. I appreciate that some absence is unavoidable for medical reasons. Although some absence can be down to illness or other authorised circumstances, I feel it is important that you know what your child's percentage is as the year progresses. It's surprising how quickly it can drop below 95% and this will be detrimental to your child, especially if it happens year after year.

Transition day

We will be having our annual transition in preparation for the new classes next year on Monday 2nd July. This will be an opportunity for your child to go to their new classroom and meet their new teacher and classmates.

I will let you know the class organisation by Friday 29th June.

Sports Day Field Events

Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school from Monday as all year groups will take part in field events in the lead up to our sports day on **Friday 15th June**. Presentations for field events will take place at celebration worship before our afternoon event.
