




#### Courage, Compassion and Creativity at Calshot 2019!

#### Job Vacancy - Clerk to the Full Governing Body

On behalf of the school, we would first like to say thank you to Kate Morey who has held the position of Clerk for the last year but has recently stepped down due to her exciting new appointment as Co-opted Governor for the school. Kate has been an invaluable asset to school governance in her time as Clerk and has in a short time made a sustainable impact on the efficiency and effectiveness of how the Full Governing Body is administered and operates.

Kate's departure now opens up a rare vacancy for the position of Clerk to the Full Governing Body, starting July 2019. This is the only paid role on the Governing Body and requires approximately 60 hours of work per year. The Clerk works closely alongside the Governing Body and is integral to administrating sound and compliant governance within the school.

We welcome applications from candidates with the following professional skills and personal attributes:

- A genuine and keen interest in educational policies and procedures.
- An ability to provide advice to the Governing Body, based on specific Clerk training plus ongoing guidance from Hampshire Governor Services.
- A proficiency to administrate meetings of the Governing Body, with a particular focus on the taking and writing up of minutes within a designated timeframe.
- A high level of integrity when dealing with confidential information.
- An understanding of compliance in relation to school governance, including maintaining records and tracking monitoring visits.
- A willingness to undertake additional duties relating to school governance, as and when deemed necessary by the Governing Body.

A full handover will be provided by the outgoing Clerk (thank you Kate!), plus compulsory enrolment onto all Clerking training courses provided by Hampshire County Council.
