Dear Parents and Carers,

It still amazes me how incredibly lucky we are as a school to have such motivated children who are so keen to make a positive difference in the school and wider community. This week we have seen our children continue with their roles and responsibilities within the school that are not only incredibly important but also of benefit to everyone.

On Tuesday, our Pupil Governors met to discuss their ideas for the term ahead and to finalise the list of books being purchased using the donation from St Stephens Church. This was kindly donated to the school after the children had presented their request for new books to the School Governors as part of their own School Improvement Plan. Not only did they win 5 -1 but they also played with the utmost respect for the other team, supported each other and showed true sportsmanship throughout. They should all be incredibly proud of how they conducted themselves and the role models they are for younger players.

We have had **more positive Covid cases** within school this week and I do need to ask all parents to continue to be vigilant and undertake regular testing. Please do ensure that if anybody shows Covid symptoms (even mild ones) that they do take a PCR test and do not rely solely on lateral flow tests to ascertain if someone is negative. As I have said before, whilst I know for most children Covid symptoms will be mild, we do need to protect staff members because if they do catch Covid and have to self-isolate this could create staffing issues and impact the school's ability to provide effective face-to-face teaching.

On a lighter note, we finished the week with a lovely Celebration Worship out on the playground this morning. As we stood outside in the sunshine, everyone was able to find that inner peace as we all allowed ourselves time to reflect on new beginnings and exciting new challenges for the year ahead.

#### **Year R Applications for September 2022**

Applications for year R admissions for September 2022 opened on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021 and close on **15<sup>th</sup> January 2022**. #### **COVID – Self-Isolation Period**

As we currently have cases of COVID-19 in the school, we just wanted to draw your attention to changes in the guidance for self-isolation:

#### Changes to the self-isolation period for those who test positive for COVID-19

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.
