You could recreate a menu to go with your pictures too!</p>	<p>Using loo roll or kitchen roll tubes, design and make your own castle. You might also include features such as a moat or stables?</p> 
<p>Create your own Queen/King role play area. Would you include a passcode for entry?</p> 	<p>The Queen has her face on stamps and coins. Create a design for your own stamp collection. It could be seasonal, activity inspired or simple.</p>	<p>Choose one of the commonwealth countries to research. Find out some facts about it and create a simple fact file. For example this could include: location, climate, population, foods produced there, main attractions etc.</p>
<p>Visit some Royal sites in London: Buckingham Palace, Great Tower of London, Windsor Castle</p>	<p>Create your own family tree. How far back can you go? Can you add photos - you will need to ask for some grown up's help.</p>	<p>If you were Queen/King for the day, what would you do and why? Choose your top 3 and write a diary entry as if you did those things.</p>

When you have finished one of the activities, colour in that piece of the jigsaw to show you have done it. It is up to you how many you do and which one you do first.
