#### Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another jam packed week of trips and activities and of course amazing learning opportunities.

Rowan and Oak were incredibly fortunate to be invited to Winchester College for a science lecture and wildlife talk. They saw the incredible properties of liquid nitrogen in a live demonstration including seeing a banana being turned into an implement that could be used as a hammer! The children were transfixed when the wildlife presenter talked about his experiences with the Osprey and other birds of prey and were able to understand the complex nature of this amazing creature including its impressive migration patterns and its homing capabilities.

In Worship this week we have focused on the issue of bullying and talked about the importance of always being kind to others and always thinking about how we treat each other and what we say. We also talked about the importance of telling an adult in school if we witness unkindness or experience it ourselves so that it can be dealt with immediately.

As I write this, we are gearing up for Fab Friday and the PG Wells Book fair. Hopefully you enjoyed sharing your child's learning with them if you were able to come and also visited the book fair. This morning the children were able to ask questions to a published author and Sparsholt parent, Emma Nicole Lewis, who told us about the process of being a writer.

At the beginning and end of the day this gate will be open to enable parents access for pick up. Thank you for your understanding and flexibility this week when this access was blocked.

- Bags2Schools DO NOT accept: duvets and blankets; pillows and cushions; carpets, rugs and mats
  (including bath, shower and toilet mats); soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing; school uniforms with
  and without logo; corporate clothing and workwear; textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material.
  Please bring your bags into school on Tuesday morning. There will be a FoSS organised collection of
  bags from bus stops for those children using the dedicated bus service from Crawley and Littleton.
