Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a wonderful start to the Spring Term and the children have been buzzing with enthusiasm. Our amazing Worship Team led the worship and explained to the other children all about the significance of Epiphany. They did a fantastic job of getting the children to interact by asking questions and taking responses and also enabling the children to reflect that every person is important.

It was such a pleasure to present our Core Christian Value awards and from what I have witnessed, I am sure that teachers had a very difficult job of choosing who to award them to this week as the children have all been amazing. When showing a perspective parent around this morning, they commented on how incredibly polite and courteous all the children were and I couldn't agree more.

Whilst I have no doubt that this term will be challenging from a Covid perspective, I know that as a whole school community we will continue to work together to protect and support each other. We have already had confirmation of a positive case since we have returned, so I do need to ask that parents continue to be vigilant, carry on with regular lateral flow testing and if any members of the family display Covid symptoms, they go for a PCR test.

As I am sure you have seen in the news, the symptoms of the Omicron variant appear to be more diverse with people experiencing a range of symptoms including:

Whilst for children it appears to be fairly mild, we do need to protect staff to ensure they obviously don't become unwell, but also so that we do not end up with high staff absences that then create challenges in being able to teach the children in school.
