Dear Parents and Carers,

This week's Worship theme has been all about Courage. The children have been reflecting on the story of David and Goliath and how they can use this analogy in their own lives. They have been thinking about what things may have been their 'Goliaths' - a topic in Maths, learning to tie their shoe laces, trying to ride a bike and how they were able to conquer these things by not giving up, continually practising, changing their approach if it was not working and most importantly learning from their mistakes. The theme of Courage was the central element yesterday when our Year 5 and 6 pupils were lucky enough to be invited to a lecture at Winchester College about conquering Everest. The children said that they were so inspired by the courage and determination shown by the speaker and understood how pushing oneself to achieve a goal is so important.

Some of our Year 2 and Year 5 pupils have been lucky enough to take part in PE based Maths lessons. It was so wonderful to see their excitement and focus as they grasped the concepts being taught and were able to continually make progress.

Many of our children have been demonstrating their leadership qualities and the courage that goes with that. The process of electing our Pupil Governors for each class is currently going on, a role which is vital in ensuring our continued school improvement. Two of our Year 6 pupils are taking the lead in reigniting our child-led lunch time Eco School Club whilst two of the Year 2 pupils showed real courage and leadership by organising a new lunchtime Top Trumps club with the support of two Year 6 pupils.

It is such a joy to see the collaboration between pupils from different classes now that we are able to mix more freely and is something that we will continue to re-embed as it is so important for children to learn from each other and work together to achieve their goals. I am so proud of all of our children and the courage and compassion they continually show.
